<p>Share a book</p>	<p>Here is a book about Fireman Fergus—encourage your child to make the sound of the siren when they are on their rescue. This is great way to encourage engagement in stories as making lots of different noises will capture the interest of your child.</p>
<p>Busy Fingers</p>	<p>Use an old shoe box or any other box that can be recycled and use it to make your own transport for someone who helps us: —a fire engine like Fireman Fergus, a police car, an ambulance, a vet's car, a teacher's car, a bus or train getting people to work... the list is endless! Let your child think of their vehicle and get them to decorate, naming colours, patterns and numbers which they may see on the vehicle.</p> <p>If you need any ideas have a look at this link from the CBeebies programme Biggleton</p>
<p>Time to sing and move</p>	<p>Do you know the song "Miss Polly had a dolly who was sick, sick, sick?" Sing this song with your child and maybe find a bag which could be the doctor's bag and pretend to be a doctor helping a dolly or toy to get better.</p>
<p>Explore!</p>	<p>On your walk around your local area spot how many post boxes you can find? Make it a game of spotting the boxes. What colour are they? What goes in there? Post a letter to a family member of friend. Do you know the person who delivers the mail to your house?</p>
